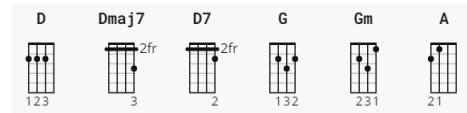

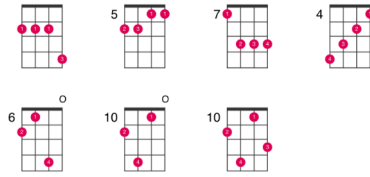
Capo: 2nd fret (making it in E)
